Various components of the SAR prepared by the Computer Department was also discussed in detail.

2. A Webinar on ‘Intellectual Property Rights and Patent process’, was conducted on 31st October 2020, as online mode. The topics were how to conduct Patent Search, Patent Process, filing, publication and granting, so as to provide an idea of patent procedure , beneficial for PhD scholars and faculty doing research.
